

There will also be points and time herding runs, too! Plus, we all enjoy the FUN DAYS when the weather is cooler!


Are you ready to try something new with BCCAZ?


Also, a time to "fix" a problem you might be having at a trial.



WHAT TAKING YOUR DOG TO THE DOG PARK ACTUALLY DOES

Teaches your dog to be overly aroused/excited around other dogs

Exposes your dog to diseases and parasites

Decreases your relevance _

Provides ample opportunity for them to practice ignoring your commands (recall, anyone?)

Teaches your dog to be fearful of other dogs (b/c now they've most likely been attacked, bullied, or overwhelmed)


Teaches your dog bad manners and social skills

Puts your dog at a high risk of being attacked by another dog

Creates higher risk for leash reactivity

Creates tons of unnecessary stress for the owner

Teaches your dog that other dogs WILL get into their personal space even when uncomfortable and that it's up to them to do something about it
